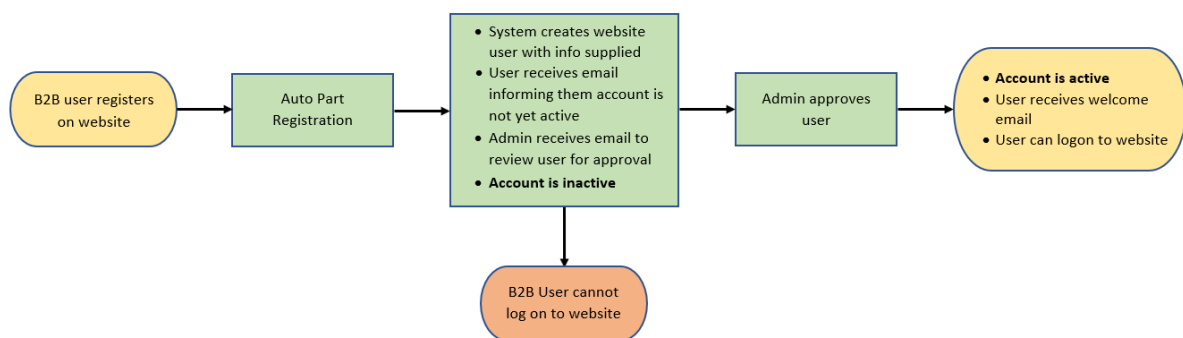
## How to register for an online account

### Overview

B2B Registration allows a trade (wholesale or business) customer user to register for B2B access and have their user (login) account linked to our ERP debtor account. Users with active accounts can log on and will receive that account's default settings (i.e. Pricing, Warehouse, Contract Information etc).

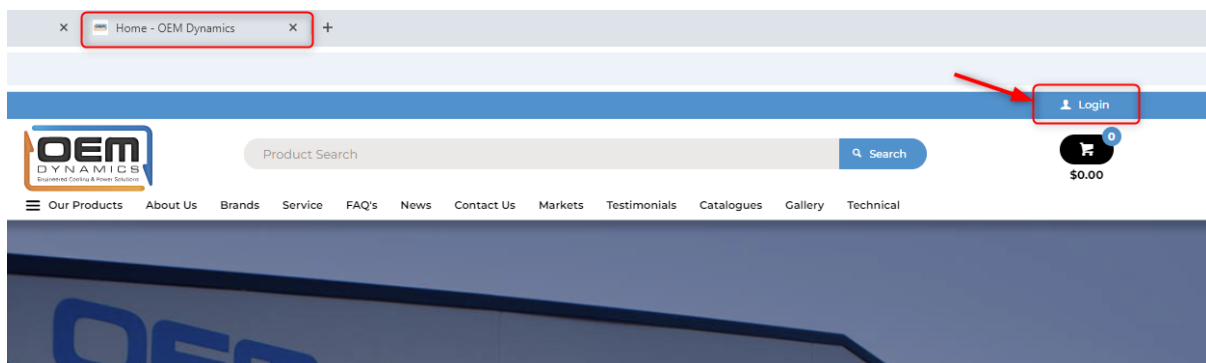

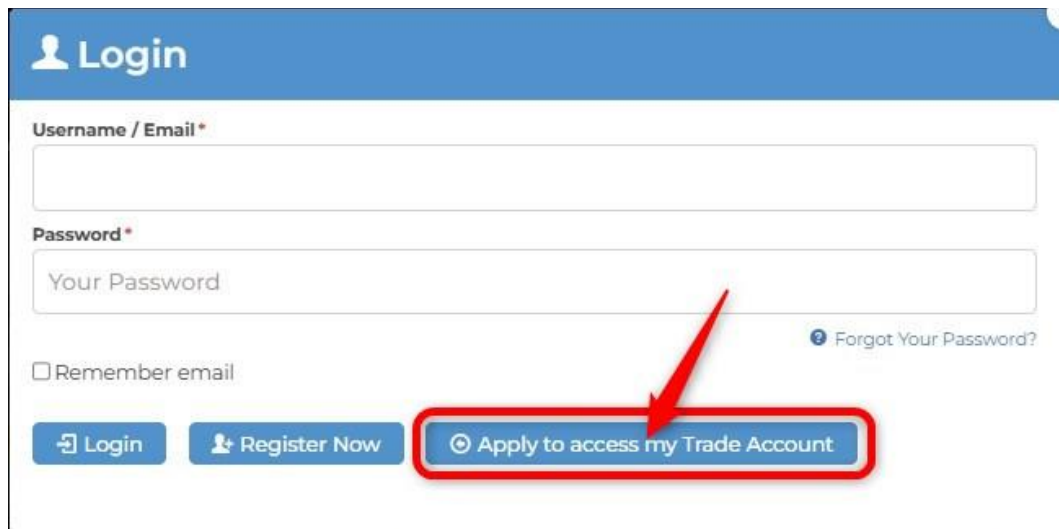
### Step-by-step. Register for an online account.

1. Navigate to any page of our website (oemdynamics.com.au) click LOGIN on right-top navigation menu.



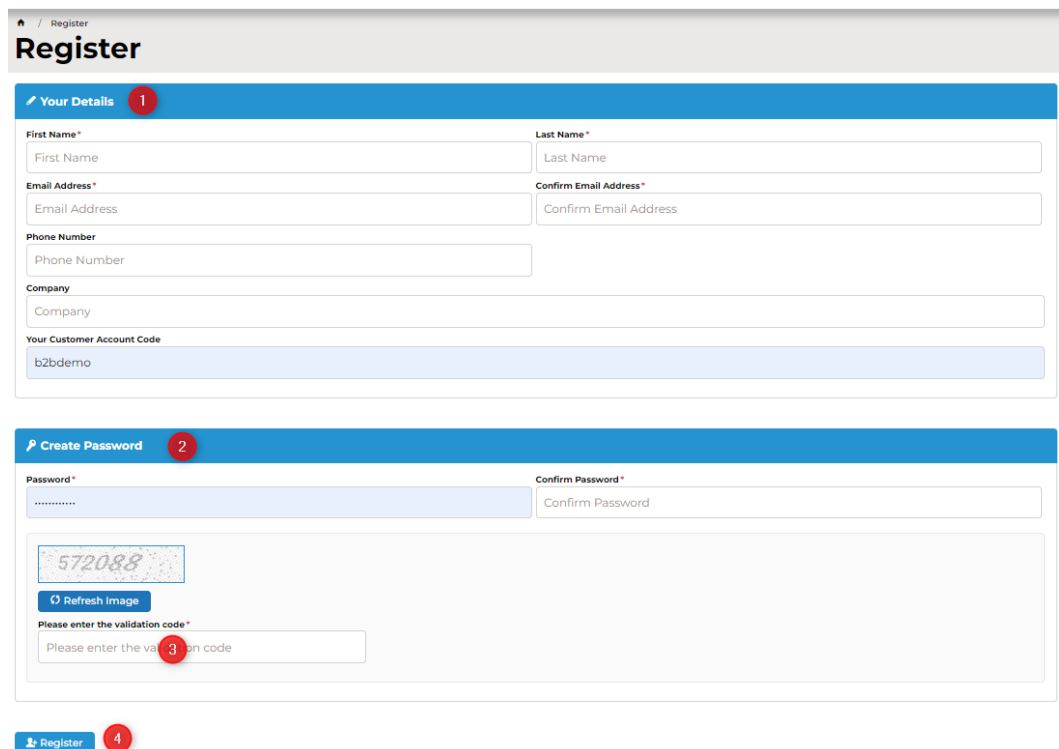

2. On the Login page, click **“Register Now”**.

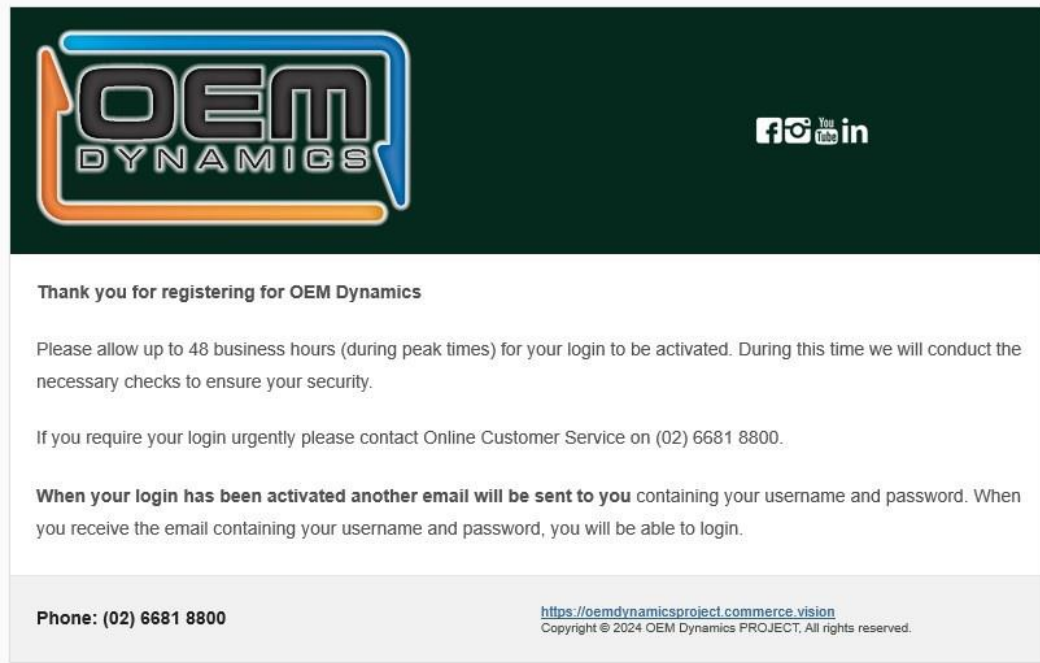
On the register page, fill out Your Details (1) and create a password (2), then enter the validation code as shown (3) click Register (4).



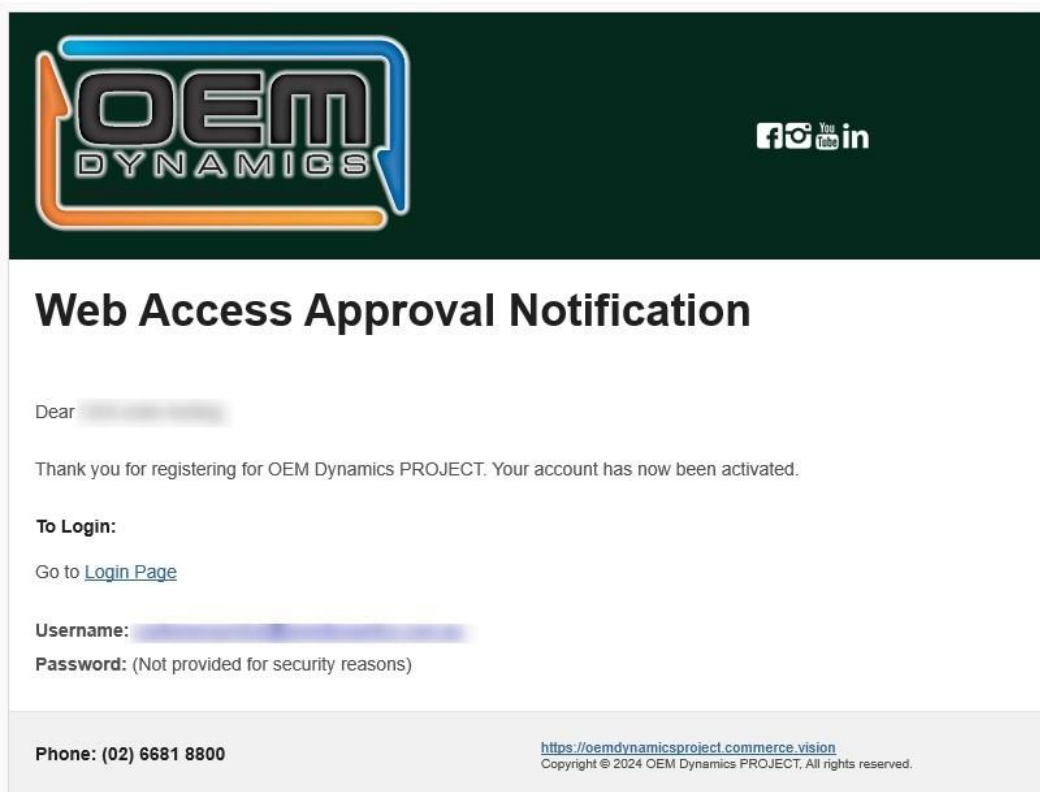

4. The application will be processed by our customer service team. You will receive an email indicating your account has been approved and can proceed to login with the username and password you created.

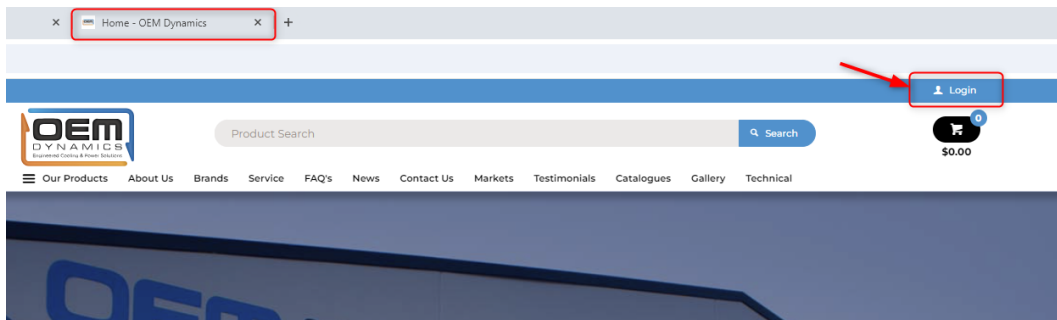

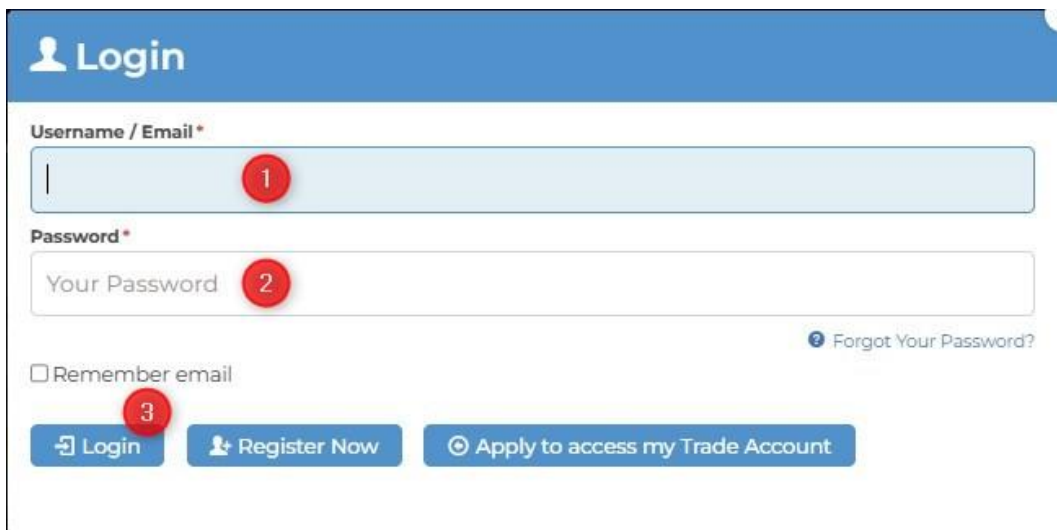
## Registered user login.

### Step-by-step. Register users.

1. Navigate to any page of our website (oemdynamics.com.au) click **“LOGIN”** on right-top navigation menu.



2. Enter your registered email address (1) and password (2) in the window, then click **“Login”** (3).
